Pursuant to the Commission's order at its meeting held on February 27, 2012, the Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and Salt River Valley Water Users' Association (collectively, "SRP") will submit their memorandum regarding the recent opinion of the United States Supreme Court in the case of *PPL Montana LLC v. Montana*, Supreme Court Case No. 10-218 ("*PPL Montana*"). The SRP Memorandum evaluates the United States Supreme Court's decision in *PPL Montana* and the applicability of that decision to the facts of the Lower Salt River case. SRP shared a draft of its Memorandum with CEMEX, Inc. ("CEMEX"). In the interest of saving the Commission's time and effort, CEMEX, by this filing, provides its full support and agreement to the SRP Memorandum.

¹ SRP submitted a copy of the United States Supreme Court's slip opinion with its Notice of Decision in Related Case and Request for Supplemental Briefing filed with the Commission on February 23, 2012.

Specifically, CEMEX agrees that the critical component of the *PPL Montana* decision for this Commission's Lower Salt River proceedings is that the Court clearly brought the law regarding navigability for title purposes back to considerations of "navigability in fact" and "commercial reality." *Opinion*, at 11, 24. The United States Supreme Court very clearly confirmed that the test of navigability for title is pragmatic in nature asking: Was the river, as of February 14, 1912, used or susceptible to being used, in its ordinary and natural condition, as a highway for commerce, over which trade and travel were or could have been conducted in the customary mode of trade and travel on water? This reconfirmed the federal test of navigability for title purposes is also the Arizona statutory test in A.R.S. § 37-1101(5).

As a result, the Commission can and should find that the Lower Salt River is nonnavigable.
