I am also a historian who has spent many years studying the Yavapai way of life. I also worked as a Docent at the Heard Museum in 2010.


2. This declaration is being written based on my personal knowledge and study of the Yavapai history.

3. This declaration is being written to the Arizona Navigable Stream Adjudication Commission regarding the determination of the navigability of the Verde River.


