A Day's Doings in Arizona

COWBOY HIT BY LIGHTNING BOLT

KNOCKED FROM HORSE, CLOTHING TORN TO SHREDS AND INSTANTLY KILLED—WERE PULLING DISABLED AUTOMOBILE.

NOGALES, August 20.—News has just reached here that, on Friday last, two men, named Sublete and Holland, were coming from Douglas to Nogales to start an auto garage, when their machine became stalled on the road at a point nine miles from Patagonia. They secured two cowboys, brothers, named Brazeamonte who were in the employ of H. B. Riggs, to help them, and they tied their lariats to the machine, pulled it out and up the hill. Arriving at the top, a heavy rain storm set in and the top of the auto was put up for protection. Sublete, Holland and one of the brothers got into the auto. Bernardo Brazeamonte remained on his horse and pulled his slicker around him. He was about ten feet in front of the machine. Suddenly a flash of lightning struck him, killing him instantly, and the horse fell on him. The members of the party rushed to him, after recovering from their shock, and as they pulled Brazeamonte from under the horse, the animal fell over dead. The men say that their escape was miraculous and they could not describe the agony of the surviving brother over his loss. The remains were buried at Patagonia. Brazeamonte's hat and clothing were torn to shreds and the slicker was cut into pieces the size of a dollar and scattered in all directions.

ARIZONA NEWS AND COMMENT

Colonel D. H. Johnson of Douglas has withdrawn from the race for the democratic nomination for sheriff of Cochise county.

Mrs. C. R. Schurz will build a fine \$3,500 residence in Tucson.

The Tucson All-Stars will play the Douglas team at the latter city Sunday, August 30.

Latest figures show that 337 carloads of cantaloupes were shipped from the Salt river valley this season.

Tucson Elks will give a big minstrel show in November.

Pima county supervisors have decided upon September 28 as the date for holding primaries in that county.

Today will be a half holiday in Bisbee, the occasion being the visit of four troops of the Fifth cavalry, which will camp near that city.

Cochise county's tax rate for the year has been fixed at \$2 on the hundred.

A large section of the wall around the territorial fair grounds was blown down and the agricultural building struck by lightning and damaged in a severe storm at Phoenix Monday evening.

Maricopa county tax rate has been fixed at \$2.16 for this year.

Rare presence of mind saved Conductor W. S. Fox near Prescott from

death when he fell from a brakebeam on a moving train yesterday. He threw himself from beneath the train in time to escape the wheels.

A free for all fight among a number of Indians at the plant of the Arizona Power company at Fossil Creek Sunday resulted in the fatal shooting of two of their number.

The tax rate in Yavapai county has been fixed at \$2.40 on the hundred dollars, a reduction of 20 cents from last year's rate.

Chris Buri was found in the railroad yards at Prescott Monday night with two empty whiskey flasks and an empty bottle which had contained carbolic acid, by his side. He was dead, and the evidence was accepted as conclusive of suicide.

The Cochise county board of supervisors have decided to ignore the recent 600 per cent raise on mining property made by the territorial board of equalization.

C. M. Holmes has left the management of the Western Union telegraph office in Bisbee and has accepted a like position with the Postal in the same city.

John J. Pool of Pool, Cochise county, and C. F. Whiteher of Globe have been granted commissions as notaries public.

The Union high school bond issue, which was voted on in Tempe Monday, carried by a very narrow margin.

Yuma county tax rate will be \$3.40 this year.

BLOODY AFFAIR IN JEROME SALOON

BRAVE CONSTABLE STABBED IN SIDE, BUT SUCCEEDS IN ENDING FIERCE RACE BATTLE—TWO MEXICANS BADLY STABBED.

JEROME, August 20.—Constable Charles King has started a free lance boom for himself for sheriff of Yavapai county by an exhibition of nerve shortly after midnight Sunday morning which has set all of Jerome singing his praises.

Unaided, King entered the Wigwam saloon, a resort largely frequented by the men who love to dally over the mezel and sing the glories of Diaz and Alfonso, and slowly chant "In Old Madrid," when the third drink gets under good headway, to find eight men slashing at each other furiously, while the place rang with bitter imprecations and the clashing of a dozen daggers.

The men, maddened by the mezel, and by racial taunts which had been passing back and forth for an hour or more, were enacting a scene reminiscent of the Grinders in Dickens' "Tale of Two Cities," paid no attention to King's commands to cease fighting, but went on slashing one another fiercely. On the floor lay Pedro Sanchez and R. A. Estrada weltering in blood flowing from ghastly wounds in their stomachs. Not a man remained in the room from whom the blood was not pouring from one or more wounds. It was time to step in if wholesale murder was to be prevented.

Drawing his gun and wading in, using the weapon as a club, King knocked the descendants of Castile and the Montezumas left and right. Steve Montero and Uraisto Mascis resented the intrusion and succeeded in laying open the skin and flesh in King's side before they were subdued. King was slashed three times, but never gave in until he had laid out the whole fighting brigade and landed those who were able to go in the Jerome calaboose. Estrada and Sanchez were taken to the hospital, where they were joined later by King, much weakened by the terrible ordeal through which he had passed.

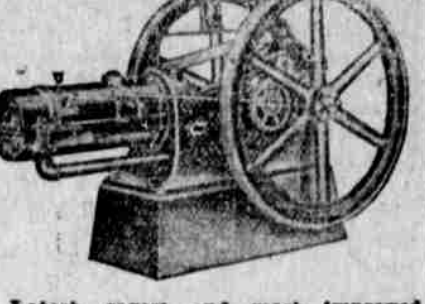
