

# MARICOPA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PUBLIC TRUST VALUES FOR THE VERDE RIVER

The following, lists the Maricopa County Department of Transportation roadway facilities within the Verde River as defined by the Maricopa County Department of Transportation, Road Inventory System (RIS) and Geographic Information System (GIS). - 3. The permittee shall cut only such timber as necessary in clearing for road construction, reconstruction, and maintenance. Timber so cut shall, unless otherwise agreed to, be cut into logs of lengths specified by the Forest Service and decked along the road for disposal by the Forest Service.
- 4. The permittee shall do everything reasonably within his power to prevent forest fires, and will not dispose of material by burning in open fires during the closed season established by law or regulation without a written permit from the Forest Service.
- 5. The permittee shall fully repair all damage, other than ordinary wear and tear, to National Forest roads and trails caused by the permittee in exercise of the privileges granted by this permit.
- 6. No member of or Delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this agreement or to any benefit that may arise herefrom unless it is made with a corporation for its general benefit.
- 7. This permit may be terminated or suspended upon breach of any of the conditions herein or at the discretion of the Regional Forester or the Chief, Forest Service.





- There is reserved to the United States, its successors and assigns, the prior right to use any of the land herein described to construct, operate, and maintain dams, dikes, levees, reservoirs, canals, wasteways, laterals, ditches, drainage works, flood channels, telephone and telegraph lines, electric transmission lines, roadways and appurtenant irrigation structures, without any payment made by the United States or its successors and assigns for such right, with the agreement on the part of the applicant that if the construction of any or all of such dams, dikes, levees, reservoirs, canals, wasteways, laterals, ditches, telephone and telegraph lines, electric transmission lines, roadways or appurtenant irrigation structures across, over or upon said lands should be made expensive by reason of the existence of improvements or workings of the applicant thereon, such additional expense is to be estimated by the Secretary of the Interior, hereto, and that within thirty days after demand is made upon the applicant for payment of any such sums, the applicant will make payment thereof to the United States or its successors and assigns constructing such dams, dikes, levees, reservoirs, canals, wasteways, laterals, ditches, telephone and telegraph lines, electric transmission lines, roadways, or appurtenant irrigation structures across, over or upon said lands.

The applicant further agrees that the United States, its officers, agents, and employees, and its successors and assigns, shall not be held liable for any damage to the improvements or workings of the applicant resulting from the construction, operation, and maintenance of any of the works hereinabove enumerated.

- 20. The permittee shall take reasonable precautions to avoid damaging National-Forest lands. Acting independently or in cooperation with and at the direction of the Forest Service, the permittee, to the extent of its available resources, shall take immediate suppression action on all fires, regardless of cause, on or in the vicinity of the area covered by this permit.
- 21. The permittee shall include in the terms of all contracts let for work to be performed on this land, such specifications for fire prevention and suppression as the Forest Service shall deem necessary to protect the Government against damage.
- 22. The permittee agrees to reimburse the United States for any and all suppression costs, and to pay all damages, resulting from any fire which originates within the limits of the right-of-way from any cause whatsoever.
- 23. The permittee shall be responsible for prevention and control of soil erosion on the Government lands, covered by this permit, and lands adjacent thereto, where such erosion has resulted from construction or

maintenance of the project, and shall do such revegetation and/or construction and maintenance of preventive works prescribed by the Forest Supervisor or his designated representative as will accomplish the result. Reseeding will be done in accordance with guides outlined in Region 3 pamphlet "Reseeding Disturbed Areas Procedure Guide" copies of which are available through the Forest Supervisor or District Ranger.

- Government-owned improvements, the relocation of which is necessitated by operations under this permit, shall be reconstructed by and at the expense of the permittee, in a manner, at the locations, and times specified by the Forest Supervisor or his designated representative.
- The permittee shall construct and maintain the road and shall install and maintain suitable drainage structures, sufficient in number to prevent the accumulation of excessive heads of water and prevent the erosion of the road surface, drainage ditches, or adjacent lands.
- 27. The road design and the construction of the road shall be such that all forms of encroachment on streams will be avoided or held to a minimum. Under no circumstances shall waste materials be deposited in, or be permitted to obstruct, natural stream channels.
- Cuts in earth shall not be steeper than 1 to 1. Cuts in rocks shall not 28. be steeper than  $\frac{1}{4}$  to 1. Fills, regardless of materials, shall not be steeper than  $l^{\frac{1}{14}}$  to 1.
- The permittee shall construct and maintain gates or other approved auto-29. mobile crossings at points designated by the Forest Supervisor or his designated representative.
- The abandoned parts of the existing highway shall be ripped and the area 30. scarified. The site shall be restored to as nearly a natural state as possible and shall be revegetated as specified by the Forest Supervisor or his designated representative.

- None of the conditions of the permit as set forth herein can be varied 32. or modified, except with the written consent of the Forest Supervisor.
- This permit shall have no force and effect until the permittee has signi-33. fied its acceptance of the provisions and conditions by signing below and returning the duplicate copies to the Forest Supervisor.







NOW THEREFORE, Grantor does hereby grant to Grantee an easement for a public road and highway along and across a strip of land, hereinafter defined as the right-of-way over and across the lands in the County of Maricopa, State of Arizona, and further described as follows:



- 2. The easement herein granted is limited to use of the described right-of-way for the purpose of construction, operation, and maintenance of a highway and does not include the grant of any rights for nonhighway purposes or facilities; Provided, That the Forest Service shall not exercise its right to use or authorize the use of any portion of the right-of-way for nonhighway purposes when such use would interfere with the free flow of traffic or impair the full use and safety of the highway; and Provided further, That nothing herein shall preclude the Forest Service from locating National Forest and other Department of Agriculture information signs on the portions of the right-of-way outside of construction limits.
- 3. Any reconstruction of the highway situated on this right-of-way shall conform with plans, specifications, and written stipulations approved by the Forest Supervisor or authorized representative prior to beginning such reconstruction.
- 4. Consistent with highway safety standards, the Grantee shall:
  - (a) Protect and preserve soil and vegetative cover and scenic and esthetic values on the right-of-way outside of construction limits.
  - (b) Provide for the prevention and control of soil erosion within the right-of-way and adjacent lands that might be affected by the construction, operation, or maintenance of the highway, and shall vegetate and keep vegetated with suitable species all earth cut or fill slopes feasible for revegetation or other areas on which ground cover is destroyed. The Grantee shall perform these activities where it is deemed necessary during a joint review between the authorized Forest Officer and Grantee prior to completion of the highway. The Grantee also shall maintain all terracing, water bars, leadoff ditches, or other preventive works that may be necessary to accomplish this objective. This provision also shall apply to waste disposal areas and slopes that are reshaped following slides that occur during or after construction.

#### 5. The Grantee shall:

Establish no borrow, sand, or gravel pits; stone quarry; permanent storage areas; sites for highway-operation and maintenance facilities; camps; supply depots; or disposal areas within the right-of-way, unless shown on approved construction plans, without first obtaining approval of the authorized Forest Officer.

- 6. The Grantee shall maintain the right-of-way clearing by means of chemicals only after the Forest Supervisor has given specific written approval. Application for such approval must be in writing and must specify the time, method, chemicals, and the exact portion of the right-of-way to be chemically treated.
- 7. The Grantee does by the acceptance of this document covenant and agree for itself, its assigns, and its successors in interest to the property here granted or any part thereof, that the covenant set forth below shall attach to and run with the land:
  - (a) That the Grantee shall operate the described property and its appurtenant areas and its buildings and facilities whether or not on the land therein granted as a public road, in full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations issued thereunder by the Department of Agriculture and in effect on the date of this document to the end that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, sex, color, religion, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any programs or activities provided thereon; and
  - (b) That the United States shall have the right to judicial enforcement of these covenants not only as to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, but also as to lessees and licensees doing business or extending services under contractual or other arrangements on the land therein conveyed.
- 8. The Forest Supervisor shall make determination as to the necessity for archeological and paleontological reconnaissance and salvage to the extent determined necessary because of maintenance of the highway facility is to be undertaken by the Grantee in compliance with the act entitled, "An Act for the Preservation of American Antiquities," approved June 8, 1906 (34 Stat. 225, 16 U.S.C. 432-433) or the Archeological Resources Protection Act of 1979 (93 Stat. 721; 16 U.S.C. 470aa-11) and State laws where applicable.
  - If, during excavation work, items of substantial archeological or paleontological value are discovered, or a known deposit of such items is disturbed, the Grantee will cease excavation in the area so affected. Grantee will then notify the Forest Service and will not resume excavation until written approval is given.
