Twentieth Annual Meet of the American Association.

Canonoque, N. Y., Aug. 4.—The twentieth annual meet of the American Canoe association, which began today at Hay island, in the St. Lawrence river, a short distance below this place, has attracted canoe clubs from all parts of the United States and Canada. The western states are particularly well represented and are expected to make a good showing in many of the racing events. Among the scheduled events of interest to western men are the division sailing races, war canoe race for the American Canoe association championship and division paddling races. The western division holds a paddling event this year for the first time, racing for the Gaddiner cup. The northwest division will have a war canoe race for valuable trophies. If present indications are fulfilled the war canoe race for the American Canoe association championship will be the biggest in the way of a paddling contest ever held in America. Among the clubs that have entered crews for all of the events are the Buffalo Canoe club, Knickerbocker (N. Y.) Canoe club, Webawawa Canoe club, Auburndale, Mass.; Toronto Canoe association, and the Canoe club, of Brockville, Canoe. Other clubs that will contest in one or more of the events are from Montreal, Kingston, Milwaukee, Duluth and Ottawa.
